

## **CHAPTER 3**

### **Municipal Officers**

#### **Section 3.1 Clerk**

- (a) There is hereby established the office of municipal clerk who shall be appointed by the mayor, subject to approval by the board.
- (b) The duties of the clerk shall be as prescribed by law or ordinance and as directed by the mayor or the board.
- (c) The clerk shall serve as municipal tax collector, and as such, his duties shall be as prescribed by law or ordinance and as directed by the mayor or the board.
- (d) The clerk shall serve as treasurer, and as such, his duties shall be as prescribed by law or ordinance and as directed by the mayor or the board.
- (e) The clerk shall file a bond of \$5,000.00 with the municipality as security for the faithful discharge of his duties in accordance with law or ordinance. (Amended by Ordinance No. 4 of 1980. Amended by Ordinance No. 4 of 1986.)

#### **Section 3.2 Tax collector**

#### **Section 3.3 Street commissioner**

- (a) There is hereby established the office of municipal street commissioner who shall be appointed by the mayor, subject to approval by the board or elected by the board pursuant to La.R.S. 33:381.
- (b) The duties of the street commissioner shall be prescribed by law or ordinance and as directed by the mayor or the board. (Amended by Ordinance No. 4 of 1980. Amended by Ordinance No. 4 of 1986.)

#### **Section 3.4 Municipal attorney**

- (a) There is hereby established the office of municipal attorney who shall be appointed by the mayor, subject to approval by the board.

(b) The duties of the attorney shall be as prescribed by law or ordinance and as directed by the mayor or the board.

(c) The municipal attorney shall serve as prosecutor in the mayor's court. (Amended by Ordinance No. 4 of 1980. Amended by Ordinance No. 4 of 1986.)
