ARTICLE A. - WEST BATON ROUGE PARISH HERITAGE TRAILWAY SYSTEM

Sec. 20-1. Trailway Rules

West Baton Rouge Parish has created a West Baton Rouge Parish Heritage Trailway System to be composed of any sidewalks, bicycle lanes and other pedestrian and bicycle facilities that West Baton Rouge Parish Government owns and/or operates and/or maintains by virtue of previous acts of the West Baton Rouge Parish Council including, but not limited to: the adopted West Baton Rouge Parish Alternative Transportation Plan as well as cooperative endeavor agreements with other Agencies. The portion of this trailway system located within the Town of Brusly – and any components thereof – is subject to the following rules of use:

(a) Permitted users and facility hours. West Baton Rouge Parish residents and visitors are invited and encouraged to utilize the Trailway System. Usage of the Trailway System after nautical twilight begins is hereby prohibited, unless there is installed West Baton Rouge Parish operated, and functional trailway lighting.

(b) Only dogs allowed / leash requirements. Pet dogs are permitted to be on the trailway system. However, pet dogs shall be accompanied by their owners or other temporary caretakers and such owners and caretakers shall keep their dogs on a leash at all times that the system is being utilized. No other animals – including horses – are permitted to be on the trailway system. Owners and caretakers shall clean-up pet wastes.

(c) No motorized vehicles. Trail users shall not operate motorized vehicles on any segment of the trailway system. This includes, but is not limited to: trucks, cars, ATVs, UTVs, motorcycles, go-karts, mopeds, motorized scooters, golf carts, et cetera. Authorized vehicles such as Atchafalaya Basin Levee District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, West Baton Rouge Parish maintenance and inspection vehicles and all law enforcement vehicles shall not be subject to this law.

(d) Use at own risk. Trail users shall use all reasonable and practical methods, strategies and techniques to avoid injury to property, self or others. Usage of the trailway system shall be at the

user's own risk. Trailway users shall obey all posted signage and shall practice safety, etiquette and proper yielding techniques.

(e) Penalties for violations. Violations of this Ordinance shall be subject to prosecution in accordance with Chapter 25 of the Town of Brusly Ordinances.
